



KAYAK RENTAL INFORMATION

The City of La Grange kayak rental cost is based on the following schedule.

	<u>Single</u>	<u>Double</u>
4 hour block (1-4 kayaks) *Monday-Friday, 8am to 5pm	\$20/ea	\$25/ea
Daily (1-4 kayaks) *Monday-Friday, 8am to 5pm	\$25/ea	\$30/ea
Weekend (1-4 kayaks) *Check-out must occur between 3-5pm on Friday *Check-in must occur prior to 10am on Monday	\$40/ea	\$50/ea
Weekly (7 Days) *Check-out must occur Monday-Friday, 8am to 5pm *Check-in must occur 7 days from date of Contract by 5pm	\$200/ea	\$225/ea
Deposit (1-4 kayaks)	\$75/ea	\$90/ea

Please call for Group Rates - 5-12 kayaks - and/or non-profit or youth organizations, and for other group information. Fees for each organization/group will be determined on a case-by-case basis.

Should kayak(s) be returned after the stipulated time, as listed above or discussed at time of rental, a late fee will apply. Late fees are \$25 per day per kayak. Anyone returning the kayak(s) late may suspend the renter from future rentals.

The City of La Grange kayak rental includes paddle(s) at no charge. A U.S. Coast Guard approved wearable lifejacket (PFD - Type I, II, III, or V) must be on board for each person. Persons age 13 years or younger **must wear** a lifejacket while on the water. The renter may provide his/her own lifejacket or one will be provided by the City of La Grange with a \$25 deposit, but at no extra charge if returned on time and in same condition as when provided. All items must be returned at designated times and in original rented condition or the renter will pay the following replacement fee(s).

Life-vest replacement fee \$40/ea

Paddle replacement fee \$25/ea

Failure to pay this fee may result in litigation and/or suspension from future rentals.

Renters must be 18 years or older to obtain rental of kayak(s), and must provide a valid drivers license. The Renter is required to sign a City of La Grange Waiver and Release of Liability form and complete a float plan. If the destination is deemed as unsafe for kayaking, then the City of La Grange reserves the right to deny usage of the kayaks. Example of such – if the Colorado River is experiencing flooding, then the renter will not be allowed to rent the kayaks for paddling

on the Colorado River. Also, at any given point, if a rental is booked and the River, or said float plan destination, is experiencing flooding and/or unsafe conditions the City of La Grange has the right to cancel any rental, with a full refund of deposit and/or rental fee.

In order to reserve the kayak(s), the renter is required to pay the deposit fee(s). No verbal confirmation will be accepted as reservation. Cancellation of reservation must be made two (2) business days prior to scheduled rental time. Should cancellation occur after the two (2) day period the renter will forfeit any deposit amount paid. Full payment of rental fee(s) is expected no later than the day of pick up.

Should any kayak classes be scheduled/held, these classes will take precedence over personal rentals.

Although it is legal to have open containers of alcohol while kayaking, it is discouraged. If convicted of boating while intoxicated the maximum fine is \$2,000 and 180 days in jail. Also, the person convicted may have their driver's license suspended. Please remember that 50% of all boating accidents involve alcohol and that the probability of a fatal boating accident doubles when the operator uses alcohol.

Waiver and Release of Liability

In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in the City of La Grange Recreation Program events and activities, the undersigned:

1. Agree that the parent(s), legal guardian(s) or primary renter of the equipment will instruct and supervise the minor participant(s). The primary renter, parent(s) or legal guardian(s) should inspect the equipment to be used and if the renter believes anything is unsafe, he or she should immediately cease to use such equipment as soon as safely possible.
2. Acknowledge and fully understand that each participant will be engaging in activities that involve risk of injury, including permanent disability and death, and severe social and economic losses which might result not only from their own actions, inaction or negligence, but also the actions, inaction or negligence of others, the condition of the premises or of any equipment used. Further that there may be other risks not known to use or not reasonably foreseen at this time.
3. Assume all the foregoing risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages and medical expenses following any such injury, permanent disability or death.
4. Release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue the City of La Grange, its council members, its administrators, managers, directors, agents, coaches, instructors, independent contractors, and other employees of the City, other participants, sponsors, advisors, and if applicable, owners or Lessors of premises used to conduct the event, all of which are hereinafter referred to as "Releasees", from any and all liability to each of the undersigned, his/her heirs and next of kin for any and all claims, demands, losses or damages on account of injury, including death and damage to property, caused or alleged to have been caused in whole or in part by the negligence of Releasees or otherwise.
5. This waiver may not be modified in any way. If any part of this waiver is determined to be invalid by law, all other parts of this waiver shall remain valid and enforceable.

I HAVE READ THE ABOVE WAIVER AND RELEASE, UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND SIGN IT VOLUNTARILY.
