This is an *Unofficial Tabulation* of the Election results. May 6, 2019 is the last day to receive late domestic ballots. The Voter Registrar will take possession of the Provisional ballots May 4, 2019. May 9, 2019 is the last day to receive certain overseas ballots. May 10, 2019 is the last day to receive certain military overseas ballots. The deadline for the voter registrar to complete the review of provisional ballots is May 10, 2019 and is also the last day that a Provisional Voter may present evidence to the Voter Registrar for Provisional Ballot to be counted. The Early Voting Board Presiding Judge shall retrieve the provisional ballots from County Voter Registrar on May 10, 2019. May 13, 2019 is also the last day for the Early Voting Ballot Board to meet to count or not count (depending on the Voter Registrar's disposition) the ballots. The presiding judge of the early voting ballot board shall make a new return sheet of the votes.

The Official Canvass of the Election returns will be conducted at 4:00 p.m., on Wednesday, May 15, 2019.
